### INTRODUCING SMC

#### THE VISION AND THE GENESIS

The demand of God on this present generation is to raise a great number of virile Christian missionaries and a host of mission minded believers as partners for these; in seeing the Lord Jesus enthroned in many places of the world. It is quite sad that a great number of Christian students are turned out every session on campuses with little or no understanding of missions. This has hitherto reduced effective workforce for missions.

The mandate God gave this movement is to raise work force for mission agencies and mission oriented churches by mobilizing and equipping Christian students for missions. This is done in conjunction with several mission agencies and mission oriented churches. Official inauguration ceremony of SMC took place on the May 20, 1995. It is expected that as the students are exposed and acquainted with various mission works, it will be easier for them to be part of any of these after their graduation.

SMC is now spreading to many institutions of higher learning and it is considered as a passing phase for student-members (revealing its nature as a movement). To the glory of God, some former student-members of SMC are now serving as missionaries with different organizations within and outside Nigeria, while others hold forth in missions in various ways.

## **OBJECTIVES OF SMC**

- a. Mobilizing and equipping Christian students for missions
- b. Sustenance of missionary zeal of students on campuses and the non-student members in cities where the campuses are located.
- c. Act as support base for many mission agencies and mission oriented churches, raising resources for mission works.

## **MEMBERSHIP**

Student Mission Club membership cut across many Christian fellowships and denominations. Members are bound together by a burning desire of seeing the whole world evangelized, starting from their 'Jeruselems'. Membership comprises both students and non-students (from different Church background and mission works). Non-students members facilitate mission activities of the student-members.

## **SPECIAL ACTIVITIES OF SMC**

- 1. VACATION MISSIONS:** student-members doing short-term mission work on partner-missionaries' fields during long vacations, ranging from one week to two months.
- 2. INTERNATIONAL MISSION ADVENTURE** - general adventure trip (by both student and non-student members) to various mission fields for a taste of missions' life. It is an opportunity to do exploit beyond one's immediate environment, especially in places with little or no impact of Christianity.
- 3. MISSIONARIES SUPPORT SCHEME-** Student Missionary Support Scheme (SMSS) for raising financial support towards the feeding of missionaries and

Missionary Empowerment Scheme (by non-students) for equipping missionaries to generate fund for their sustenance on their mission fields.

- 4. ON-CAMPUS MISSION SCHOOL (OMS)-** Missions education for practical teachings on missions, effective evangelism, spiritual warfare, skills and vocations in missions. This takes place at least once in every session on many campuses.
- 5. LOOK-** an annual conference of SMC members and other like minded believers from all walks of life.

## **REGULAR MEETINGS**

SMC members on campuses meet regularly at agreed time (based on the peculiarity of their each institution) for outreaches. The non-student arm (The Battle Axe) members in strategic towns also meet regularly for prayers, planning and outreaches .

## **ACTIVITY GROUPS AND UNITS**

The club provides a wide range of opportunities for believers to freely participate in missions. They are;

1. Missions Communication: Publications, Research, Publicity, Recording, Technical and Library.
2. The Explorers: Evangelism and Discipleship
3. The Overcomers: Intercession, Spiritual warfare, and Deliverance.
4. The Blessed Generation: Skills and Vocational services.
5. Good Samaritans: Raising material, financial and moral support for missions.
6. The Battle Axe: Non-students facilitating all forms of training programmes like OMS, seminars, conferences, etc.

## **SMC LEADERSHIP STRUCTURE**

Each SMC chapter has its own Executive members. Zonal and National Executive members are drawn from local leaders and ex-officio.

## **MEMBERSHIP CODE OF CONDUCT**

- a. Every member is expected to be a genuinely born again Christian, a lover of missions and a consistent member of a fellowship or church.
- b. Every student-member should be academic-excellence conscious.
- c. Every member is responsible towards the movement prayerfully, morally, and financially.
- d. Any act of indiscipline or ungodliness is not tolerated among members.
- e. Training in the On-campus Mission School is compulsory for student-members while non-students go through induction.
- f. Student-members are left to God's leading in their choices of mission works after graduation.
